#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

##### SPECIALTY VETERAN CLASSES

The following Veteran Classes are offered:

Veteran Dogs (7 yrs. - under 9 yrs.)

Veteran Bitches (7 yrs. - under 9 yrs.)

Veteran Dogs (9 yrs. - under 11 yrs.)

Veteran Bitches (9 yrs. - under 11 yrs.)

Veteran Dogs (11 years and older)

Veteran Bitches (11 years and older)

First Place Winners of the Veteran Dog Classes and Veteran Bitch Classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition, if otherwise undefeated at this specialty show. Ribbon prizes will be awarded for first through fourth place in each Veteran Class.

**Note** - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Independent Breed Specialties.

#### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

##### AWARD OF MERIT

Following Best of Breed Competition, the Specialty Breed Judge, at his discretion, may present Awards of Merit, to up to 10 percent (rounded up to the next number) of the total number of dogs competing in the Best of Breed Competition; which shall include move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and first place winners in Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes. The dogs selected for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are not eligible for an Award of Merit. The dogs selected for Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible for an Award of Merit.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes, Involving Multiple Dog Entries, is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry, judged first in these classes, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won one of these classes.

**BRACE CLASS** - This class will require an entry fee of \$27.00 as a UNIT, as a first entry, or \$21.00 as an additional entry of BOTH dogs. The Brace Class shall be for two (2) Bernese Mountain Dogs. (*Effective January 1, 2005: A Brace is defined as two (2) dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.*) The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. The entry form for each dog entered in the Brace Class must be marked "Brace Class" in the space provided for "Dog Show Class" or "Additional Classes." If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, designate Brace #1, Brace #2, etc.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

JUDGE: MR. WILLIAM (BILL) SHELTON

**ENTRY FEE:** \$10.00 as a first entry, or as an additional entry, of the same dog.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Each Bernese Mountain Dog entered in a Junior Showmanship Class may be entered in one of the breed classes, or may be entered for Junior Showmanship only. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. An entrant that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show, or the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. **Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship is entered on both front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.**

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSIFICATION

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS** - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**MASTER CLASS** - (*effective date of January 1, 2012*) This class will be for Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER** - The Junior Handlers placing first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for Best Junior Handler.

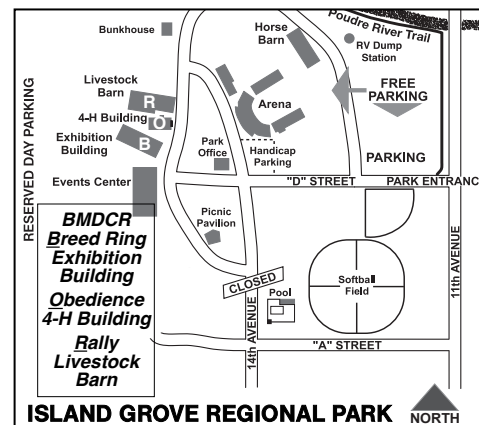
