The March 15, 2015 board meeting of the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of the Rockies was called to order at 12 pm at the home of Al and Laura. Present were Lori, Lou, Laura, Tracey, Dottie, Barb, Patti and Candy with Julia absent.

Approval of Minutes - Lou moved to approve the minutes from the last meeting, Candy seconded and the motion carried.

There was an executive session from 12:10-12:15 pm.

Report of the President – Lori welcomed those present. Lori reported that the Yahoo group for Board members has been set up successfully.

Report of the Secretary – Laura had nothing to report.

Report of the Treasurer – Tracey reported that we have the following amounts, in round numbers, in our accounts: \$10,900 in rescue, \$16,900 in checking and \$12,100 in savings.

Committee Reports

-Rescue – Anne reported that Beulah is doing well and that we are up to date with all of her expenses including food and medications and that she has had one TPLO surgery.

-New members – Lori reported that there are three new voting membership applicants, Angie Porter and Marcia Zuger. Angie has attended two meetings and will be voted on during the general meeting. Marcia has attended one meeting and will be voted on during her second meeting.

Unfinished Business

-Trademark/Copyright update – no update at this time

-2015 Regional – Dottie reported that the AKC application has been sent in, that we have contracted all of the judges and that committee chairs have been filled. There is still a need for raffle items. The dinner has been organized.

-Spring and Fall Draft Tests – Lou reported that we need to order ribbons for the Spring and Fall Draft tests so there will be an expense for this.

-Membership Task Force – This has been postponed until the next meeting.

-May Meeting Date/Freestyle demonstration – The person to do the freestyle demonstration asked if our May meeting could be rescheduled so as to not fall on the Memorial Day weekend. After some discussion, the Board decided to put June 7th forward to the general membership for approval as the next meeting date.

New Business

-Storage Unit - Lori reported that the monthly cost of our storage unit will increase from our current average of \$100 per month to \$125 per month. There was discussion regarding other options other than a storage unit but the consensus of the Board was to continue renting this unit. Dottie moved that the club pay up to a maximum of \$150 per month, Candy seconded and the motion was approved. This will be presented to the general membership meeting for approval.

-Berner Fiesta – There was discussion regarding possible locations, dates and catering and the need to make a reservation. Candy will check into possible locations. July 26th was suggested as a possible date for this event.

-Nancy Fuselier, Mary and Daily Bugg – Possible donations were discussed as a way to honor Nancy Fuselier's husband who passed away recently. When asked, the family had suggested donations to the Civil Air Patrol and the Board discussed possible amounts. The Board will put this to the general member-

Approval of Minutes - Val moved to approve the January 2015 meeting minutes. Lou seconded and the motion carried.

Report of the Secretary – Laura had nothing to report.

Report of the Treasurer – Tracey reported that we have the following amounts, in round numbers, in our accounts: \$10,900 in rescue, \$16,900 in checking and \$12,100 in savings.

Committee Reports

-Rescue – Anne reported that Beulah is doing well, that we are up to date with all of her expenses including food and medications and that she has had one TPLO surgery. Marcia has attended one meeting and will be voted on during her second meeting.

-2015 Regional – Dottie reported that the completed AKC application has been sent in, that we have contracted all of the judges and that committee chairs have been filled. Dottie will post deadlines pertinent to this event. There is still a need for raffle items. The dinner has been organized. Val indicated that we are doing well on trophies but are open to additional donations.

-Spring and Fall Draft Tests – Val reported that the Spring Draft test is up to date. Sharon will finish and

When asked, the family had suggested donations to the Civil Air Patrol. Candy moved and Ann seconded that the club donate \$150 to the Civil Air Patrol in Daily Bugg's honor. The motion carried.

-National Specialty Basket – Dottie reported that she will take the basket to the National Specialty and thanked the club for the \$200 donation for the basket.

-Puppies available – Sara reported that Claire had 12 puppies in Boulder and that she still needs homes for a few of the female puppies.

Adjourn – Patti moved and Val seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned for brags at 2 pm.

Sue has two dogs presently, a Yellow Lab and a Golden Retriever. Her titles are numerous: AKC CD, CDX, RN, UKC-CD, and in the world of dog dancing: W-FD/MF, W-FDX/MF, W-FDM/MF, W-CH,FD/MF, W-PDP-FD, W-FD/HTM, W-FDX/HTM, W-FDM/HTM, W-CH.FD/HTM. She enjoys learning as much as she can regarding obedience and dog dancing.

Since 1999, Sue has been a familiar face at BSKD and her passion is teaching freestyle dog dancing because of the creativity and challenges involved. Teaching her students to excel in this sport gives her much satisfaction. She has several students who have attained the highest titles in dog dancing. KPT is also one of her favorite classes to teach because she thinks it is so important to teach owners how to train their puppies correctly from the beginning.

Sue always said that her yellow Lab, "Sir" made her look good. The pair were able to attain the highest title in dog dancing on April 27, 2013. That title is the PDP in Musical Freestyle (Perfect Dance Partner). During their journey in dog dancing, they never NQ'd. They won the High Artistic and High Technical pair each time they competed in Musical Freestyle. In Heel Work to Music, they won the High Artistic 5 times and High Technical 4 times. She is also proud that in 2008, they competed in dog dancing with others from different countries and won the prestigious "Attila Award" which is equivalent to High In Trial in AKC Obedience.

She feels the most important things to teach a dog/owner is how to bond with your dog. How to gain the trust, love, attention, motivation, and desire to want to do whatever he/she can do for you.
